Harold Munn's "Faith In Doubt" at Christ Church Cathedral

What happens when an atheist and a believer find themselves next door neighbours? What happens when religion finds itself in a culture of science and secularism? Could they hold hands? Could they fall in love?

Churches are declining throughout the West, and none of the big evangelism programs have made any difference. What if the problem isn't programs, but that churches are speaking a language that isn't understood in secular society? What if churches learned to speak secular? What would that sound like?

Harold Munn was convinced by his dog to be an atheist when he was eight years old. So what effect did that have on him when he taught science in East Africa, led congregations in the Yukon, was Dean of the Anglican Cathedral in Edmonton, worked with homelessness, addictions and mental health issues in downtown Victoria, and with climate action disruptions in Vancouver? He found a way to speak secular and rediscover the power of the faith within the secular worldview.

He tells his own love story between faith and science, and the love story of a believer and an atheist, in his new book, *Faith In Doubt*. Its unveiling takes place at Christ Church Cathedral on Friday, June 28th at 7:30pm, with readings and conversations.
